


**Activity 1 :3-D Gumdrops Solid Figures( ROLL NO 1-18)**

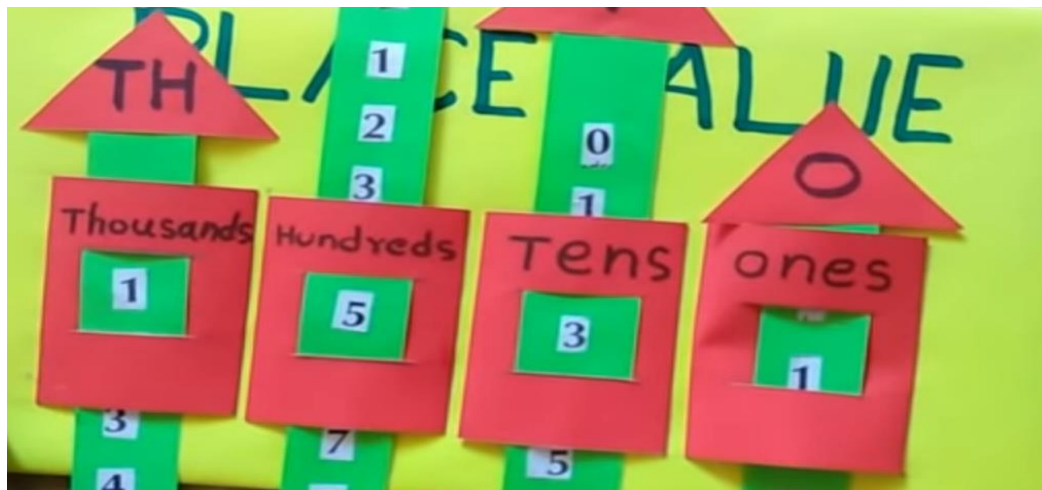
Use toothpick/earbuds and paste them with gumdrops at the corners, make solid figures and answer the below given table.
