Dwarka International School emphasizes on the Holistic development i.e., Cognitive, Social-Emotional, Physical and Language development of the child in both academic and non-academic spheres.

This year the government of India with a view to strengthen the country's education practices has brought forth the National Curriculum Framework. This has been done in order to keep pace with the emerging new trends globally and in order to ensure that our students receive meaningful education and move away from rote learning.

The Key features of NEP from which the NCF has derived are learning by doing, development of creative and critical thinking skills and strengthening of literary and numeracy skills in Foundational Level. In order, to integrate Kindergarten in formal education NEP has proposed a 5-year Foundational level instead of a Four year as in practice now.

With the proposed introduction of Junior KG coming in from next session, certain changes have been proposed in the Curriculum for the Foundation Level. These changes are effective across all schools of India.

Keeping the above in mind, and as per the fresh guidelines received (Wide circular no. DE.23(399)/Sch.Br./2023/246 & NCF 2022), some notebooks issued to the students may not be fully used during the session. This is because more emphasis will be on hands on activities and on planned worksheets. Parents are requested to keep the partially used notebooks carefully as they will be continued in the next session.

All updates regarding the implementation of NEP and NCF will be shared with the parents on a regular basis.
