



## Mathematics Week

The celebration beautifully blended creativity, logic, and learning, encouraging students to view mathematics as an exciting and meaningful subject—a day when numbers truly came alive.





## GC Merrakii Edu Globe 2025



# HUMAN RIGHTS DAY




Today, our school conducted a meaningful morning assembly to mark Human Rights Day, highlighting the value of equality, dignity, and respect for all.


## SPRING -O- MAGIC
