




# Independence Day Celebration



The Dandiya Night was truly a memorable celebration that brought the school community together, spreading smiles, laughter, and festive joy all around.







"Tricolour Soars High: School Marks Independence Day with Vibrant Special Assembly"





Mr. Singh also shared tips for evaluating completed worksheets effectively, ensuring constructive feedback, and integrating digital tools from Extramarks to track progress.






# WORKSHOP ON PROJECT DEAR ME
